When due

The Plymouth Surveyor recently stated that this vessel had received considerable damage, which was stated to have been sustained in Fowey, but he had been informed by the Master that the services of the Norwegian Veritas Surveyor only were to be employed.

The Bergen Surveyor who was requested to ascertain from the Owner his intentions as regards the retention of the vessel's classification, now forwards a cablegram stating that the Owner does not wish the class to be retained.

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.
