VESSEL'S NAME ANDROMEDE NO. 1 REPORT Msl. No. 10584

The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

"The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class of this Hopper Barge was omitted from the reprint of the Register Book in Jan. 1944.

Notation of 'Reclassification Contemplated' is now assigned.

The MARSEILLES Surveyor reports (12.46) and in a letter dated 13.9.47 that on account of vessel having been scuttled in 1944 by demolition charges the hull from approximately stowhead forward bulkhead to stern badly damaged and would require complete renewal; and the Owners state that they do not intend taking re-delivery of the hull from the French Government, and in the opinion of the Surveyor the French Government will in all probability sell what remains for breaking-up purposes.

This report is forwarded for the information of the Committee.

It is submitted the notation of 'Reclassification Contemplated' be deleted from the Register Book.
