Dear Sir,

I have for acknowledgment your letter of the 24th instant respecting the survey of the Hopper Barge "ANDROMEDE N°1" and in reply, have to say that the Owners have now confirmed that they have no intention meantime of repairing the hull, but as the boilers have been surveyed and recommendations made, they have requested me to complete the survey and issue a certificate when repairs are completed to my satisfaction.

In respect to this, I should be glad to learn if it will be in order to issue an interim certificate in the name of the vessel or Report 10 using a distinguishing mark, as there is a possibility of the boilers being used for another vessel.

Regarding the hull, no inspection or recommendations have so far been made and I should also be glad to learn if I should forward for record purposes Rpt.8, giving a rough report on the extent of the damage.

I understand that there is a possibility of the fore part of this barge being used to replace the damaged section of the sistership "ANDROMEDE N°2".
