REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Hull damage on account of vessel being scuttled by the Germans during August 1944 by demolition charges.

Found.—Hull from approximately stowhead forward bulkhead to stern badly damaged, section would require a complete renewal.

The Owners state that the vessel is now the property of the French Government and they have no longer any interest in the Hull or Machinery.
