With reference to your letter "F" of the 17th December, 1935, respecting the freeboards of the above vessels, we beg to state that the surveys have been carried out as requested in your letter.

In the case of the "CASSIOPEE", we have to state that this vessel is being towed to Roulon by the "ANDROMEDA NO. 1" and, in addition to her usual equipment the boiler only is full of water, and about a ton of oil fuel being left in the tanks.
