I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th instant and also your telegram of today, as below, regarding the ships "ANDROMEDA No. 1", "ANDROMEDA No. 2" and "CASSIOPEE" and I accordingly enclose Freeboard Certificates and copies valid for the voyage to Toulon for issue when the freeboards indicated have been marked and verified and you have satisfied yourselves in each case regarding the preparations for the voyage. In the case of the "CASSIOPEE" you should also satisfy yourselves that there is no undue concentration of loading of the vessel. It is also considered that an Annual Freeboard Survey should be carried out on the "ANDROMEDA No. 2" and I have to request that you will be guided accordingly.
