

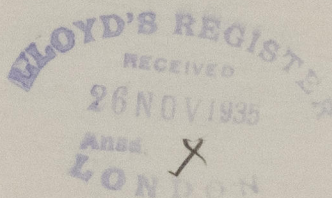

"JAMES NO. 64", "JAMES NO. 65" & "ERNI"

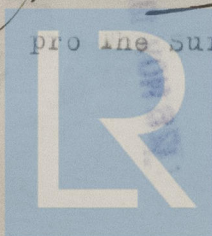
