Dear Sir,

I beg to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Society's Surveyor at Bergen stating that the S.S. "MOTO" has been transferred to the ownership of Messrs. A/S D/S Neptun, under your management, and re-named "TETUS", and that it is desired not to maintain her classification in the Society's Register Book.

As you are no doubt aware, this vessel, which has been laid up in the Tyne since the beginning of 1931, became due for First Special Survey No.3 in April, 1932, and her class has hitherto been allowed to remain undisturbed, whilst laid up, in consideration of an undertaking, furnished by the late Owners, that all overdue surveys would be held before she again proceeded to sea.

The case has received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today, and, in view of your decision and of the circumstances as detailed above, I am directed to say that they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
