No. 141, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that in accordance with the Rules printed in German the sheerstrake should be 940 x 13 millimetres. As the breadth of the sheerstrake has however been increased to 1060 millimetres, the thickness ~~will~~ in the circumstances, be approved at 12.3 millimetres (to 12.6 m/m) without further compensation.
