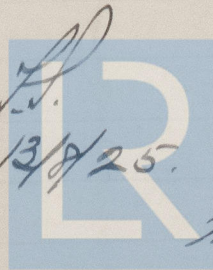
A modified survey of Oil Engines became due at the end of May last.
