Nature of Survey

This vessel, built in 1923-6mo. was classed 100 A.1
Shade deck with freeboard, For service in the Adriatic.

The vessel has recently come under survey at Trieste when it was intimated to the Society's Surveyors by the Owners that the retention of the class in the Society's Register was not desired, the vessel being classed with the Registro Italiano.

This is in accordance with the policy of the ^{Lloyd Trieste} ~~Company~~ as intimated in their letter of the 30th January 1923, in which the Society was informed that only the vessels owned by that Company which were engaged in service in the extreme Orient would retain the Society's classification.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu indicating withdrawal of class at the Owners' request.
