This vessel has now been assigned an International Convention Freeboard by the Registro Italiano Navale ed Aeronautico which has been verified and for which we enclose herewith a verification form duly completed.

The only alteration was the raising of the height of the air pipes which are all situated on the Poop, Bridge and Forecastle decks and are now 18" in height from the deck to the opening.

Those from oil fuel compartments being fitted with gauzes and those from water compartments with wood plugs attached by a chain.
