Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their Meeting to-day the case of your steamer "ADIGE", referred to in your letter of the 6th ultimo addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Hamburg, and I am directed to say that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
