Whenever the movement of Anchors or Chains is reported, the particulars should be clearly stated in the space provided on back of this form. State also the dates and initials of any letters respecting this case.

Where cases where the Surveyor has not made a special damage report he is required to state whether he has rendered his services for this purpose and to whom and why they were declined
