QUESTION.

ANSWER.

I shall be glad to receive a reply to my memorandum of the 1st ultimo, which is repeated below :-

"I have to inform you that the validity of the "Examined" notation will expire at the end of next month, and in these circumstances I shall be glad to learn what arrangements are proposed to be made for the Special Survey (D) to be carried out in connection with the reclassification of this vessel.

You will observe that the Boiler Survey also will become due at the same time."

Date:— 11th August 1949

It is regretted your Memorandum referred to was not received in this office.

Messrs. Lloyd Triestino state they do not propose to class this vessel with Lloyd's Register.

It will be observed that pre-war, when the vessel was under the same Ownership, she was not classed with the Society.
