With reference to your letter of the 10th inst. regarding the steamer "VAZLAV VOROVSKY", I have to inform you that on the 1st of December being at the works of Messrs. P. Smit Jr., where this vessel was lying, I have met the representative for the Owners who stated that he had carried out a little more than first intended, but that the whole of the repairs were not completed.

I noted that the bulkheads had been dealt with but at the same time that in No. 3 hold on each side a large cement box over the after part of the hold about 2 feet square had been fitted, and explained to him that we could take no further action, but to recommend that repairs had to be finally carried out to the Society's satisfaction before the vessel's proceeding to sea.

The vessel was in the meantime partly loaded and has now left this port without any further action being taken.
