S/S "VAZLAV VOROVSKY".

We beg to confirm our telephonic conversations of Monday evening and Tuesday morning when you informed us that on account of the work recommended by Lloyd's on your S/S "VAZLAV VOROVSKY", in hold No.3, damage by fire, you would withdraw her class, and that also the work mentioned by your Captain on the web frames, longitudinal frames and the bottom (see our letter of yesterday) would be carried out under entirely new Superintendence, and that we have no longer to put ourselves in communication with Lloyd's respecting this matter.

For the regularity of the matter we beg you to transmit these instructions in writing to Lloyd's Register of Shipping, Rotterdam.
