S. Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith a letter, dated 22nd instant, which has been received from the Owners of the Steamer "PERONNE", calling attention to the absence of the Special Survey cross from the particulars of this vessel's classification in the Register Book.

As you are aware, the construction of this vessel was commenced before classification with this Society was contemplated, and in the space on the report form against the inquiry "State whether the vessel has been built under Special Survey" the Surveyor inserted the word "No".

The Owners now state that when the Society's Surveyor was called in he surveyed every piece of work which had been performed up till then, in conjunction with their Consulting Engineer. The Surveyor in question, Mr. S. A. G. Nash, has unfortunately been invalided since the vessel was built, and in the circumstances the Chairman suggests that the case is one which, with a full statement of the facts, should be submitted for the further consideration of the Liverpool Committee, as to whether or not the Special Survey cross could be assigned.
