Nature of Survey

~~REPAIRS TO ENGINES AND BOILERS DUE TO DAMAGE THROUGH~~

A rivet head found missing in the starboard boiler lower forward longitudinal butt strap. The rivet has now been renewed and the hole reamed true.

There is no previous history of any similar defect, and all rivets in the butt strap have now been satisfactorily hammer tested. The Surveyor recommends, however, that the starboard boiler lower forward longitudinal butt strap riveting be specially examined at the next Boiler Survey.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed.
