Dear Sir,

We are in receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant, Ref. "H", and in reply beg to state that, should intend to put any of the Dumb Barges or Tugs, enumerated the fact of your letter, into commission, we are agreeable that the surveys which are now overdue shall be carried before the vessels are sent to sea; and, should we have any of these vessels, we will inform the intending charterers that the annual surveys are overdue.

We observe that you include the Lighter "CRETEFIELD" in the list of barges owned by us and due for survey, and would advise you that this vessel was sold to Mr. Geoffrey Cooper, of Waterford in May last and, so far as we know, employed by him for storage purposes at that port.
