Dear Sir,

With reference to your telegram and letter of the 10th instant regarding the equipment of the steamer "WAR DRUMMER", which it is understood has now been purchased by your Company, I beg to acquaint you that when this vessel was built she was supplied with 210 fathoms of 1-15/16" chain cable as a war emergency measure instead of 270 fathoms as required by the Society's Rules.

In accordance with a circular issued by the Committee of the Society in April last, the proper requirements for chain cables should be brought up to the length prescribed by the Society's Rules at as early a date as possible.
