

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 10th instant in respect of the steamer "GRANDLIEU" and in reply thereto, have to say that it is the Owners intention to have the bunker hatchways on the Freeboard deck in the bridge space submitted to examination on the vessels return to this port in about 3 weeks time, and at the same time full particulars of the shifting beam, covers, coaming and battening arrangements, etc.. of No.3 hatchway in the bridge space, together with the thickness of the wood covers and the bearing surface of the bunker hatchways on the bridge deck will be forwarded. Regretting this omission from the Freeboard Report.
