

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 4th instant in respect of the S.S. "GRANDLIEU", and in reply thereto, have to state that :-

(1) the bunker hatchways on the bridge deck are provided with efficient wood covers, two tarpaulins and satisfactory battening down arrangements. The Owners state that the bunker hatchways on the freeboard deck in the bridge space are provided with efficient wood covers, one tarpaulin and satisfactory battening down arrangements. Owing to cargo and coal, it was impossible for me to examine these hatchways.

(2) No.3 hatchway in the bridge space is provided with an efficient hatch web, wood covers, satisfactory battening down arrangements and one tarpaulin.
