In reference to my letter of the 7th instant respecting the freeboard for the steamers "MARTINIERE" and "CAMBRONNE", I beg to enclose herewith 5 request forms for freeboard filled in by the Owners for the steamers "MONCOUSU", "SAINT)TROPEZ", "BRANCAS", "GRANDLIEU" "ST.)FERREOL".

The Steamers will arrive in due course at this port starting with the steamer "MONCOUSU" about the 15th instant; "SAINT TROPEZ" about the 21st instant; "BRANCAS" and "GRANDLIEU" about the 28th instant, and the "SAINT)FERREOL", about the 16th January, 1933.

The Owners do not state by which regulations they desire the freeboard assigned, but as in the case of the "CAMBRONNE" and "MARTINIERE" they wish the freeboards to be as advantageous to them as much as possible.
