

at this port, and in reply thereto would state that the storm  
mentioned in my report, are fitted in riveted channels, and  
the full height of the openings in the bulkhead at the after  
part of the bridge.

With reference to the alteration of the freeboard markings  
mentioned in your letter, I would state that the vessel left this  
port on June 5th. 1919, bound for Java to load for England, and, as  
she is not likely to return to these waters, I would recommend that  
the information be forwarded to Messrs. Alfred Holt & Co. Liverpool,
