S.S. "ROMA" (ex Aircraft Escort ship ATHELING)

With reference to Jacksonville report No.1494 and previous correspondence on the above vessel, which was assigned the notation "Classification contemplated" by the American Committee on the 31st May last, I have to inform you that in view of a letter received from the Owners indicating that they intended to complete the classification survey in Italy, full instructions were duly sent to the Naples Surveyors, at which port the vessel was observed to have arrived.

The Naples Surveyors have now written that the Owners intend to complete the survey for classification with the Registro Italiano only and do not wish to class her with Lloyd's Register at present, although they state they may perhaps find this advantageous in the future.

In the circumstances, the case has been submitted to the Committee here, who have given instructions for the notation "Classification contemplated" to be deleted from the Register Book.
