I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 24th ultimo and have been in touch with the owners of this vessel at Naples.

They inform us that the purpose of their letter to you was to request information as to the progress of the survey in America, and more particularly as to the items examined and found in good condition as they wish to present this list to the Registro Italiano at Naples as evidence that the parts named have been examined by the Society's Surveyors.

They further inform us that it is not their intention at present to have Lloyd's Register class for this vessel although they may perhaps find this advantageous in the future.

They have requested us to supply them with the copy of reports 1.8 and 9, and the plans forwarded by you. I should like to have your instructions in the matter and suggest that in the circumstances the surveyors at Jacksonville might be asked if the fees charged for the survey so far done have yet been paid, so that this question may be taken up by us if necessary at the same time.
