In reply to the enquiries contained in your classing letter of the 26th instant, we desire to state that in the case of the s.s. "IERE", Middlesbrough report No.13688, the thickness of the upper deck stringer plate should have been given as .38, as approved, and we regret having inadvertently shewn this as .36.

The capacity of the deep tank forward of the s.s. "RESTAURADOR", Middlesbrough report No.13615, is $37\frac{1}{2}$ tons and that of the deep tank amidships is 91 tons.
