On examination of vessel afloat found damage, all on port side, as follows:-

Plating of soft nose plate and No.1 forecastle sheer plate set in, and forecastle deck plating in

is buckled. Gunwale angle buckled and rivets started. No.1 forecastle deck beam buckled and

lashed bracket broken away. this damage is well above the water, temporary repairs only were carried out at this time.

It is recommended that permanent repairs be carried out at first opportunity.
