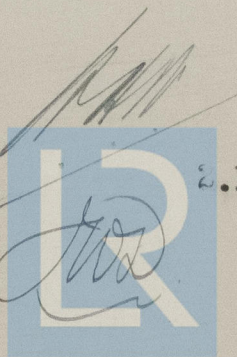
When due
