Dear Sirs,

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With reference to Mr. Pearce's telephone call recently respecting the motorships "A.A. COWAN", "JOSEPH FLINT" and "EKETIAN", I have below details of the Surveys required in each case for classification of these vessels:-

"A.A. COWAN" and "JOSEPH FLINT" - The full requirements of Periodical Special Survey (C) of the hull will require to be complied with, together with a complete Special Survey of the machinery and electrical equipment and examination of the screw shaft.

I have to inform you that the fee in each of these cases, based on the scale for Surveys held in the U.K., would be a minimum of £32 for the hull, £28.16s. for the machinery and £7.10s. for the electrical equipment, exclusive of the Surveyor's expenses. These amounts, however, will require to be adjusted to conform to the practice of the port where the Survey is held, and an additional fee will also require to be charged if exceptional repairs are carried out.

"EKETIAN" - The requirements for reclassification are the same as above, but in view of the vessel's size and survey fees, based on the U.K. scale, would be a minimum of £54 for the hull, £24 for the machinery and £7.10s. for the electrical equipment, as above.

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out the Reclassification of these vessels, and at the same time inform me of the date at which they will be held, that the Society's Surveyors may be placed in full possession of the facts of each case to enable them to carry out these surveys as expeditiously as possible.
