
I think it well to let you know that Mr. Brunelliere, the Society's Surveyor at Nantes, writing on the 21st instant states that the sister vessels, "LA HAGUE" and "LA HEVE" which are at present classed with this Society have been transferred to B.V. class.

The enquiry regarding these vessels was made in respect of the refrigerating machinery installation which is just due for survey.

As regards the ships themselves, no survey is due for class maintenance for some years.

Obviously we shall have to expunge the Society's RMC class at once, but I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Owners and let me know whether the transfer of class is now complete and whether they wish us to withdraw L.R. class from the Register Book immediately or wait until the first survey (namely the Screwshaft) becomes due.
