s.s. "BALTANNIC" ex "WESTLAND" ex "ZAA NSTROOM"

This vessel was built by the Rotterdam Dry Dock Co. in 1913 and is classed with the Bureau Veritas. She has now been purchased by the United Baltic Corporation and is in dry dock and under survey at Rotterdam with a view to classification in this Society's Register Book.

The Owners' Superintendent states that the screw shaft was drawn in at Rotterdam about 10 days ago and examined and found in good order by the Bureau Veritas Surveyors and by a representative of Messrs. Flannery Gregson & Co. for the new Owners. When the lower half of the stern bush was rewooded. The shaft is fitted with a continuous liner. The Owners require that this examination of the screw shaft might be accepted.

It is submitted in the circumstances this examination of the screw shaft might be accepted in this instance, provided the shaft be drawn in and examined in ~~not~~ ^{not less than} less than two years time.

The Rotterdam Surveyors should be advised by cable.
