Dear Sir,

You were good enough to authorise us to make use in the case of our cargo steamer "VENDEMIARE" and "BRUMAIRE" of the anchoring chain as supplied although the total weight was lower by 200 K. to that required by your Rules.

The chains of our cargo steamer "BRUMAIRE" No.39, were altogether 18300 K. against 18500 K. as required by your Rules, thus a deficiency in weight of 230 K.

On the other hand you pointed out to us that the total weight of the anchors put on board this steamer is 5720 K. whereas your Rules require only a weight of 5030 K.

We beg you therefore to be good enough to authorise us to keep for the "FRIMAIRE" the chain as supplied notwithstanding the slight difference in the weight required by your Rules.
