became due for Special Survey No.1, following an early Special Survey No.3, at the end of last month, except as regards the "TRAIN FERRY No.1", in which case the same survey will not become due until September next.

In reply to enquiry, the Owners state that it has been decided not to continue the classification of these steamers in the Society's Register Book, and in the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the cases before them on Friday, 1st instant, decided to give instructions for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
