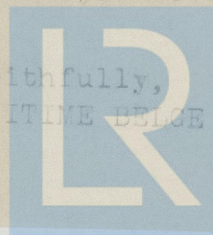
We have for acknowledgment your note dated 17th instant regarding the General Examination, Freeboard Certificate and Boiler survey of our s.s. "KATANCA". We note that all these surveys are due by the end of June 1945 and we shall take the necessary steps in due time to have these carried out by that date, or as soon after as possible when the vessel returns from her actual voyage.

BOILERS. As you know, the boilers were examined during the vessel's stay in Liverpool last December and extensive repairs were carried out under your surveyor in Liverpool, mainly to the centre of which backplates were renewed and also one furnace.

DRYDOCKING. We have also received confirmation that the vessel was drydocked in Antwerp from 29th March to 6th April 1945 for examination of the hull and repairs to plating.

We shall let you know in due course when the vessel is back in this country and will contact your surveyor to complete the examination and boiler survey.
