With reference to my letter of the 24th May last, it is observed that this vessel has arrived at your port and I shall be glad to learn how the case stands.

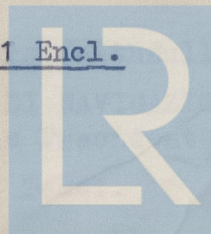
