It is concluded the ribs, frame + shell in way of the 36" frame spacing are as required in the midship section but the Surveyor should state if this is so, and also state clearly whether a middle line bulkhead has been fitted in the deck tank as stated on the report or whether the alternative arrangement shown on the drawing has been adopted. The thickness of the 144 buttstrips & sheer strake below in wells should also be forwarded.
