The Oil Engines of this vessel became due for
Modified Survey in October last.

In September last, the Society's Surveyors at
Marseilles reported that the area of the rudder had been
increased, and the Bureau Veritas, with which Society the
vessel is also classed, accepted the alteration subject to
the vessel being employed solely in the Mediterranean Service.
Under the Society's Rules, the alterations effected to the
rudder would entail an increase of one inch in the diameter of
the rudder stock below the lowest pintle.

In a letter, dated 15th ultimo, however, the Owners
state that it is not desired to maintain the vessel's
classification in the Society's Register Book, and in the
circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case before
them on Friday, 30th ultimo, decided to give instructions for
the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book
and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating
withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
