Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have recently had before them the reports of survey held on your new steamer "MONTEZUMA", in the case of which a Downton pump and a kedge anchor have not been supplied.

In the circumstances, the Committee desire me to explain that the omission of these articles has been approved by the Committee only as a War emergency measure for the duration of the War, and subject to the condition that the Downton pump and kedge anchor will be supplied after the War, if then required by the Society.

It is concluded that you will be agreeable to this arrangement and I shall be glad to be favoured with a line from you to this effect.
