I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant enclosing for cancellation the old freeboard certificate in duplicate in the case of the steamer "CAPE VERDE", and to thank you for your attention.

I may say that the particulars of alterations carried out to this ship have been inserted on the freeboard report C/11.

- 3. Suitable provision has been made for closing the openings of all the six pipes available for use in any part of the ship, which have to be used by the crew.
- 4. Doors and locks on the machinery casings have been made efficient.
- 5. Renewals and port repairs have been carried out on the covers on the fidley gratings, port ventilator casing to the stockhold and to the mainroom tops of the 6 ventilators on the poop deck.
