I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 25th ultimo respecting the ferry steamers "EORABAY" and "EILYE" and am much obliged for your attention.

In the circumstances the receipt of your further information in regard to these vessels is awaited in due course.

I think it well to add that the Screwshaft Surveys of the ferry steamers "ERDEK", "GEMLIK" and "SARCOY" have now become due, and in the event of it being decided to maintain the classification of these vessels in the Register Book it will be appreciated if you will kindly notify the Owners to this effect. In the case of the "ERDEK" and "GEMLIK" the survey falls due at the end of September, and at the end of January last in the case of the "SARCOY".
