Dear Sir,

In reply to the Wokingham letter of the 19th January, regarding spare parts for the steam lighters "VIC49", "VIC50" and "VIC51", I beg to state that no spare gear for the engines and boilers was supplied to these vessels, other than the engineer's outfit as specified. A list of items included in this outfit is given below.

3 - 5 gall. oil drums.  
Ashcock hose.  
Set of spanners and rack for stowage.  
Spare set of firebars,  
Vice and bench.  
Ash bucket.  
Salinometer and pot.  
Set of firing tools and shovels.  
Two bulkhead, two hand and one gauge lamps.  
Two oil feeders.  
Hand hammers and chipping hammers.  
3 chisels and 3 files.  
Packing screws and sticks.

It will be remembered that these vessels were built to specification, but not to class, and in accordance with Wokingham letter of the 9th August last were assigned notation of L.M.C. without the
