Sir,

I have to acquaint you that the case of the Finnish
"KATRINA" referred to in your memo of the 19th ultimo,
submitted to the Committee at their meeting today.

With regard thereto, I am requested to point out that
Special Survey has been held on this ship since 1937, and for
reason the Committee are unable to agree to the Owners'
proposal, to postpone it until the end of the year.

With a view to meeting the Owners' wishes as far as
possible, however, they will be prepared to agree to the Special
Survey being postponed for the present subject to a satisfactory
Examination now being held, but they must insist on
compliance with Special Survey requirements not later than
1st October next, if the vessel is to retain her class.

Please inform the Owners accordingly and be guided by
Instructions.
