Re: S/S "Fritz Hugo Stinnes" ex "Eastern Trader"

I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 26th ultimo and in reply to inform you that, as this vessel was originally built under the Special Survey of this Society, it is not the custom to issue separate certificates for the testing of material.

I may add, however, that the boiler material in the case of this vessel was made in this Country. The tensile strength of the shell plating was 28/32 tons per square inch, and all other plates of flanging quality 26/30 tons per square inch.
