Re: S/S "Fritz Hugo Stinnes" ex "Eastern Trader"

As you probably know, approximately 2 months ago we have taken over the former S/S "Eastern Trader" from Eastern & Mediterranean Shipping Co., Ltd. The steamer was put into Flensburg Docks for classification and repair and after completion the steamer sailed off.

At the same time the two boilers had to be altered according to German regulations, i.e. with two water-gauges. When measuring and overhauling the two boilers the question arised out of which material they were built. We have not got any support about this and therefore we beg to ask you to send us a test informing us about the construction and the material of the boilers.

We would appreciate it very much, if you could send us this test as early as possible in order to get the papers for the boilers we need.
