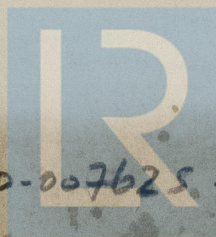

The First Special Survey No.1 of this vessel became due in September, 1925, and has been partly carried out, but the completion of the survey has been deferred owing to the vessel having been laid up for some time past, and the usual form of undertaking was furnished by Messes. Thos. and John Brocklebank, Limited, the former Owners.

The vessel has recently been sold to Messrs. P. Henderson & Company, and the Society's Surveyors <sup>at Greenock</sup> state they understand that her classification is to be transferred to the British Corporation.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee on Tuesday, 25th instant, when it was decided to recommend to the General Committee that the class should be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request, and the Owners have been informed of this recommendation.
