Nature of Survey

First entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Glasgow Surveyors should be informed that this vessel has proceeded to their port for the purpose of being fitted with her machinery; and to complete the survey for classification the freeboard requires to be verified when finally assigned by the Committee, and the engine and boiler casings permanently riveted up after the machinery has been fitted. The Surveyors should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and, on completion of the survey, to report the same on form No. 8 for the information of the Committee, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
