F. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th ultimo intimating you have been informed by the Owners of the steamer "PORTO GRANDE" that the freeboard which is at present marked on the ship's sides is according to the figure given on the freeboard certificate, viz. 1'-0 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", and not 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " as stated in Mr. Erskine's report, and that when the repairs to the deck plating are being effected, you will instruct the Surveyor to verify the markings.
