We have been in touch with the Owners who have not already had any of their vessels classed with this Society, but they do not appear to be disposed to indicate the reasons for which they are withdrawing the class of this vessel.

It has been pointed out to the Owners that as the Special Survey was almost completed the survey expenses during the next 4 years involved in maintaining the vessel classed with this Society would be very small indeed, but they stated that their decision was not one taken for economical reasons and expressed their regret at having had to arrive at this decision.
